1) Over the summer Luke earned 262 dollars mowing lawns and another 239 dollars trimming weeds. To the nearest hundred, how much money did Luke make total?
ten hundred
 $300 + 200$ $262 + 239$
 500 $501 = 500$

2) A candy company sells 360 boxes of sugar candy and 700 boxes of chocolate candy every day. To the nearest ten, what is the sum of the boxes of candy they sell?
ten hundred
 $360 + 700$ $360 + 700$
 1060 $1060 = 1060$

3) A cookie company held a poll asking customers their favorite type of cookie. 822 people said chocolate chip and 120 said oatmeal. To the nearest ten, what is the combined number of votes for both cookies?
ten hundred
 $820 + 120$ $822 + 120$
 940 $942 = 940$

4) While playing a trivia game, Team A scored 906 points and Team B scored 991 points. To the nearest ten, how many points were scored total?
ten hundred
 $910 + 990$ $906 + 991$
 1900 $1897 = 1900$

5) At the bank, a customer turned in 302 dimes and 103 nickels. To the nearest hundred, what is the total number of coins the customer turned in?
ten hundred
 $300 + 100$ $302 + 103$
 400 $405 = 400$

6) For her birthday Emily received 228 dollars from her friends and another 219 dollars from her family. To the nearest hundred, how much money would Emily have total?
ten hundred
 $200 + 200$ $228 + 219$
 400 $447 = 400$

7) A farmer was planting seeds in a garden. He planted 265 radish seeds and 253 turnip seeds. To the nearest ten, how many seeds did he plant total?
ten hundred
 $270 + 250$ $265 + 253$
 520 $518 = 520$

8) A chef was buying different soups. She bought 781 cans of chicken soup and 920 cans of mushroom soup. To the nearest ten, how many cans of soup did she buy all together?
ten hundred
 $780 + 920$ $781 + 920$
 1700 $1701 = 1700$

9) Lana was downloading apps to her phone. The first app she downloaded was 686 kb and the second was 114 kb. To the nearest ten, what was the total size (in kb) of all the apps she downloaded?
ten hundred
 $690 + 110$ $686 + 114$
 800 $800 = 800$

10) Carl and Amy were collecting cans for recycling. Carl collected 460 cans and Amy collected 665. To the nearest ten, what is the total number of cans they collected?
ten hundred
 $460 + 670$ $460 + 665$
 1130 $1125 = 1130$
