- 4) Gwen was practicing drawing super heroes. Each day she drew forty-three pictures. How many pictures would she have drawn after forty-five days?
- 5) A pizza store sold thirty-three pizzas each hour. How many pizzas would they have sold after fifty-eight hours?
- 6) A teacher had eighty students in her classes. If each student completed ninety-five problems, how many problems would she have to grade?
- 7) If an industrial machine could make forty erasers in a second, how many erasers would it have made in fifty-four seconds?
- 8) Haley had seventy-five shelves of DVDs. If each shelf had twenty-nine movies on it, how many movies did she have total?
- 9) At the carnival there are eighty-six students selling tickets. If each student sells sixty-six tickets, how many tickets would be sold all together?
- 10) Sarah has fifty-nine albums of photos uploaded to facebook. If each album has eighty-seven pics in it, how many pics does she have total?
- 11) There are seventy-two plates in a box. If a restaurant bought fifty-one boxes, how many plates would they have total?
- 12) John was placing his spare change into stacks. Each stack had thirty-nine coins. If he had twenty-eight stacks, how many coins did he have all together?
